# Trails at Bronte Creek

Walking the trails of Bronte Creek Provincial Park is an excellent way to explore the park and see all of its unique natural landscapes and wildlife. On the day use side of the park you will find four nature trails and many kilometers of connecting foot paths to explore. Each season brings with it a new reason to visit, so get out there-- hike, bike, walk, rollerblade or ski --most are also wheelchair accessible.

Trail	Length	Description	Parking lot access
Maiden's Blush Trail	1 km	This paved trail winds through mature forest and is suitable for walking, rollerblading and cycling. This trail is wheelchair accessible.	Lot C
Half Moon Valley Trail	2km	The Half Moon Valley trail explores the Bronte Creek valley and the parks early history. It includes some steep climbs and may not be suitable for children or disabled visitors.	Lot F
Trillium Trail	1km	Trillium trail is the best place in the park to see spring wildflowers and catch a breathtaking glimpse of the valley floor. This trail is wheelchair accessible.	Lot F
Ravine Trail	2.7 km	This linear path meanders along the top of the valley between the Spruce Lane farm and the picnic area by parking lot A	Lot A & Lot F
