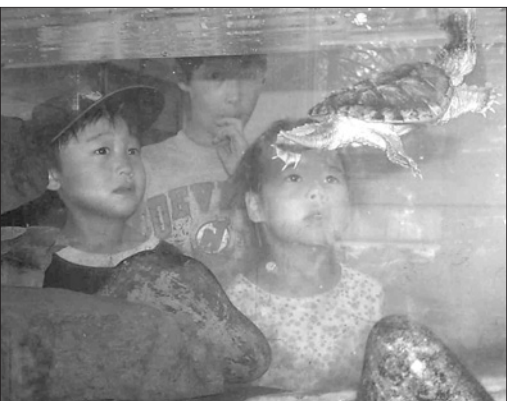


Nature Centre - Parking Lot C

Our live animal displays include snakes, turtles, toads, fish and a honeybee hive. Report your wildlife sightings to the Nature Centre staff or check out the latest sightings for yourself. Staff are available to assist you with identifying the plants and animals you see during your stay.

Kids will have fun exploring in our discovery room or looking at creatures of the night in the nocturnal room.

Playbarn - Parking Lot C

As you enter the Day-use area it is hard to miss the big Red Barn. This Pennsylvania Barn was built in 1885 and has been converted into a children's play area. The hay loft is now filled with slides, tunnels and jumping pits. Kids 10 years of age and younger can jump, slide, crawl and climb for hours.

Open everyday except Christmas Day. Parents please note that the Playbarn may be unsupervised.



Farms - Parking Lot C or F

Visit the Children's Farm where you can see a variety of domestic animals which could include: pigs, sheep, chickens, rabbits and goats. Food dispensing machines are available.



Spruce Lane Farm is home to our Belgian horses, cows and pea fowl. You can also see more pigs and our boar. If you don't see the horses or cows in the paddock look for them in the pasture.

Look for the new Farm Animal Identification panels posted near each barn. The farms are open everyday except Christmas Day, drop by to see what's new!
