Vehicle Passes - a great family value!

It makes sense with Bronte Creek Provincial Park being so close to home! Visit everyday to walk your dog or visit weekly with the kids or grand kids. Once you have the pass you will always know where to go for picnics, special events and general recreation. Each pass entitles a passenger vehicle with up to 14 people free entry to any provincial park for day use (pool fees extra, camping not included). There are three types of passes that are available to purchase.

To enjoy Bronte Creek Provincial Park all year round for swimming, skating and other activities including our annual Maple Syrup festival

or Playbarn, the annual pass (valid April 1 - March 31) is available for \$110.00.

If you plan to use the park solely in the summer for our swimming pool, nature trails, rollerblading trail, recreation facilities and picnic areas, the summer pass is valid April 1 - November 30 at a cost of \$70.00.

The winter pass is valid December 1 - March 31 for those who wish to visit the park throughout the winter months only to enjoy our skating rink, toboggan hill and cross country ski trails, the winter pass sells for \$50.00.

All passes can be purchased at the either park gate and/or park office.
